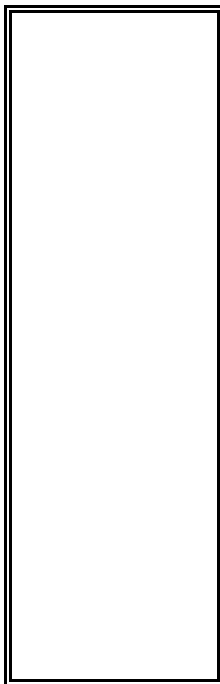

## Additional Trial Rules

1. The Management will exercise every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it must be understood that neither the Club nor the management will be responsible for loss or injury.
2. PLEASE TYPEWRITE OR NEATLY PRINT ALL ENTRIES when filling in entry forms. Neither the Club nor the Trial Secretary assume responsibility for a wrong entry.
3. No dogs wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class (except Ch 1 Sec 16b).
4. There shall be no drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the Trial grounds or premises.
5. All ties will be determined by run off. Any dog not present when called for the run off forfeits rights to compete for that prize.
6. No special award will be mailed or delivered. An exhibitor whose dog is eligible for a special award must be present or appoint a representative to accept the award for him.
7. No provisions are made for unentered dogs on the show grounds. There is limited shade, please bring your own.
8. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

## Cleanup is Your Responsibility!

If your dog soils the parking lot, show grounds or the rings, it is your responsibility to clean it up. By signing the entry form at this show you are agreeing that clean up is your responsibility. Clean up items if needed are at the check-in table or at ring-side. Exhibitors are responsible for policing after their animals.

## Notice To Exhibitors

1. Telephoned, conditional, and unsigned Entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
2. Post dated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Trial Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor(s) may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
3. DECLINATION OF ENTRIES: The Club may decline any entry for cause, and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.
4. CHANGES, additions, cancellations, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or email prior to close of entries. Changes received on the telephone are unacceptable.
5. ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners alone are responsible for the correctness of entries, or for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which the dog is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Due to cost of processing, no refunds less than \$4.00 will be made.
6. ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event's Show Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.
7. BITCHES IN SEASON are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class of the trial, then the club will refund the entry fee. **A processing fee of \$10.00 per entry will be retained.** A signed veterinarian's letter stating the bitch is in season must be provided as documentation with the request or within one week of the trial to receive a refund.
8. A \$3.00 AKC EVENT SERVICE FEE will be required for each entry of a dog at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. A \$.50 AKC Recording Fee is required for each first entry of each dog. These fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). Each first entry in Rally includes a \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee and each additional Rally entry contains a \$3.00 Recording Fee, which is collected by the Show-Giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club.
9. CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY AND SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form approximately one week before the event. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify Trial Secretary.
10. CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. We suggest dogs be present one hour before scheduled time of judging.
11. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club and/or its Trial Secretary will not be responsible for, and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.
12. THE SHOW GIVING CLUBS, THE TRIAL SECRETARIES, their agents or employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of their parents or guardians. The Clubs will take every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it is understood that the Napa Valley Dog Training Club will not be responsible for loss.
13. NO DOGS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE SHOW AREA except those regularly entered in the show. There will be no provisions for unentered dogs at this show. ALL DOGS shall be kept on leash or confined, except when being judged or in the exercising ring.
14. ALL AWARDS WILL BE MADE in the judging ring to the person exhibiting the dog and that person shall be considered the owner or the agent. All claims for trophies must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging, and the Trial Secretary should be advised at once of any discrepancy. The show-giving club and its officials disclaim any liability for any awards not claimed on the day of the show.

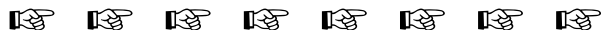

## AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

## INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in, over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries close after the date acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
